#### One Sunny Summer Day

After a few minutes leaning against the tree across the street watching the guys unload the truck, it happened. I first got a glimpse of the blue paint and the shimmering chrome. What is that, a bicycle? No, it's a mini-bike, holy cow! They have a mini bike! What is that now...a red one too.....are you kidding me? So now I had to go across the street and see this up close and personal. As I came around the back of the truck I see this little blond haired kid (who was to become my best friend of the past 40 plus years) standing there holding onto the handle bars of the blue mini-bike. I got bitten by the bike bug that day my friends and it was the best summer ever.

Over the next couple of years it seemed that more of my friends were getting motor-bikes. One got a Honda 70, another got a Honda 100 and yet another got a Honda 90. Of course, by now, my best friend and I had been riding his blue and red RUPP mini-bikes every chance we got. I was getting pretty good at trail riding and having a blast doing it. Did I happen to mention that the RUPP mini-bike is an automatic? It's important to mention because the next bike I got to try was my other friends Honda 70 mini dirt bike...it was not an automatic. This was going to be the first time I had to use a clutch and shift gears. So in his driveway I jumped on, all confident and that, because I had been riding the RUPP a couple of years...right? I twist the throttle, let out the clutch and the bike takes off! I go flying down the driveway toward the house at what seemed like Mach speed. Now, not having a clue as to how to stop this rocket ship I'm on which is on a collision course with the house, I decide to try and bail-out. I grab the brakes and the rear tire immediately locks up, (because I had no idea you had to pull in the clutch) I start to skid and bam, I come to a crashing stop right into the garbage cans beside the house. Wow! What a rush. The bike wasn't hurt and neither was I. So my buddy says, "Wow, not bad, try it again". So I did and by the end of the day I was riding and shifting gears like a pro.

So now it's about this time that I start to beg my dad for a motorcycle, mini-bike, a bicycle with a motor or anything that I could ride that had a motor and two wheels. The answer was always "not now, maybe some other time". That wasn't working for me. As much as I appreciated my friends letting me ride their bikes, I needed to have my own. I stated saving my money to buy one myself. I saved half of the money needed to buy a Honda XL 100 street and trail. My dad ponied up the difference and the rest is history. We had a hunting camp in Cooks Forrest and I rode the wheels off that bike there. Next I purchased a Kawasaki KE 100 road and trail which I used to get back and forth to my summer job while I was in High School. Eventually that was sold so I could by my first true street bike, a Kawasaki KZ 400. My best friend, the one I learned to ride with on his RUPP mini-bike had also purchased a KZ 400 the following year. We rode everywhere together, we even crashed into each other once, (no one got hurt).

The KZ 400 was the bike that truly started my love affair with street bikes. One after another they just kept coming, every few years trading up for a bigger, badder, better, faster bike. Throughout all this time I was always dreaming of owning a Harley. In September of 2005 that dream came true. A brand new Vivid Black 2006 model of the Heritage Softail Classic. I must have died and gone to heaven. Black and all that chrome, what could be better?

Joining the local H.O.G. chapter and meeting some of the best people I have ever known, Is what made it better. Having the bike of my dreams and riding it with people who love riding Harley's as much as I do was the best thing ever. The people I met in the former Butler chapter and the people I have come to know in the Pittsburgh chapter have not only become friends but I consider them/you family. Being involved with this Chapter as an officer and the former Butler chapter as an officer have been some of the best times of my biker life. Being able to server the chapter as the Web-Master has been terrific and I have appreciated the opportunity to do so.
